**Object: Adhesive recommendation – use of neoprene adhesive**

---

Hereby we, as Tarkett, confirm that the use of neoprene adhesive is not longer recommended nor approved in combination with our flooring.

Neoprene adhesives present many risks for:

- Installers health: skin and eye irritation and may cause drowsiness or dizziness.
- Safety: solvents are highly flammable liquid and vapor, has huge impact on environment
- Flooring: color migration (yellowing), impossibility to recycle (pollution)

For those reasons, adhesives manufacturers have developed alternative solution as:

- Acrylic contact adhesives
- Dry tapes

Depending on the situation, stairs installation, skirting fixation, coving of floorcovering, those solutions have many advantages: time, scrap management, pollution, safety...
